The Board will work on sharing the mowing responsibilities and will be reimbursed for time and gas. The Board requested the City Clerk investigate getting a quote for the properties that needs to be bushhogged.

The City Clerk presented a list of items for surplus. The Board voted unanimously to surplus all items on the list and authorized the City Clerk to negotiate an acceptable price.
